

US GUIDANCE FOR COVID-19 ILLNESS OR EXPOSURE

SCENARIO 1

Regardless of Vaccination Status

- Have **symptoms** *OR*
- Medically directed to test *OR*
- Tested positive

For work site or other requirements, contact your HR partner

- **STAY/GO HOME;** no in-person work **until tested** (if traveling for work, contact your HR partner)

1. NEGATIVE TEST RESULT

May return to work when fever free for 24 hrs (without the use of medications) AND symptoms are improving

2. POSITIVE TEST RESULT

No symptoms – end isolation after day 5

AND wear a mask through day 10

Mask can be removed earlier than day 10 after 2 sequential negative tests 48 hours apart, taken after day 5

If symptoms develop isolation day count starts over

With symptoms – may end isolation after day 5 **IF**

Fever free for 24 hours (without use of medication) AND symptoms are improving

Mask can be removed earlier than day 10 after 2 sequential negative tests 48 hours apart, taken after day 5

If symptoms have not improved by day 10, continue to isolate until they improve
If experiencing moderate* or severe* illness or have a weakened immune system, isolate through day 10

- Dak COVID ST Disability may apply; documentation required
Medical note, copy of test result, or picture of at home test result
- Inform Supervisor ASAP of medical guidance or changes
- Work from home may be approved

- Supervisor communicates known information to HR Partner and Leaves@Daktronics.com

- Management/HR/Safety will provide guidance when coworkers/customers/vendors will be notified

Scenario 2

Regardless of vaccination status, as soon as you find out you were exposed*

Reminder COVID can develop up to 10 days after exposure

- Immediately start precautions:
 - Should wear a mask from day 1 through 10
 - Watch for symptoms, practice good hygiene
 - Day 0 is the day of last exposure
 - Day 1 is first full day after last exposure
- If no symptoms
 - May continue in person work
 - Continue to watch for symptoms
 - Should wear a high quality mask for 10 days when around others
 - Day 6 get tested – even if no symptoms
 - If negative, continue precautions as above through day 10
 - If positive, move to Scenario 1
- If symptoms develop at any time in days 1-10, move to Scenario 1

*DEFINITIONS

- **EXPOSED**
Meeting one or more of the following after contact with someone who tested or is presumed positive or exhibiting symptoms
 - Within 6 feet for 15 min within a 24 hour period
 - Direct physical contact (hugging, kissing)
 - Shared eating or drinking utensils
 - Contact with respiratory secretions (cough/sneeze)
- **Moderate Illness**
Experienced shortness of breath or had difficulty breathing due to COVID
- **Severe Illness or Weakened Immune System**
Hospitalized due to COVID
- If you are unsure if the symptoms are moderate or severe, or if you have a weakened immune system, speak to a healthcare provider for further guidance
