EXPOSED

Meeting one or more of the following after contact with someone who tested or is presumed positive or exhibiting symptoms

- -Within 6 feet for 15 min within a 24 hour period
- -Direct physical contact (hugging, kissing)
- -Shared eating or drinking utensils
- -Contact with respiratory secretions (cough/sneeze)
- Moderate Illness •

Experienced shortness of breath or had difficulty breathing due to COVID

- Severe Illness or Weakened Immune System Hospitalized due to COVID
